I recently purchased two superb lots of a new find of green fluorite with galena, sphalerite, and chalcopyrite from Naica, Mexico. These often have intense green centers with excellent galena crystals up to almost three inches. The fluorite is mainly cubic, octahedral, and modified dodecahedrons. The specimens are from thumbnail to 14 x 9 inches.

Also, I have the new mimetite from Mapimi, Mexico; two Tsumeb collections; specimens from the Marshall Sussman and Chalerie Key Collections; adamite, cuproadamite. and paradamite from Mapimi, Mexico; cobaltoan calcite from Morocco; superb Indian minerals; and looking at two collections tomorrow.

I will be updating from Tucson within the next five days.

We are progressing with the fire. We will need to rebox 6 - 7,000 flats. The logistics and damage have been any expectation of mine.
