

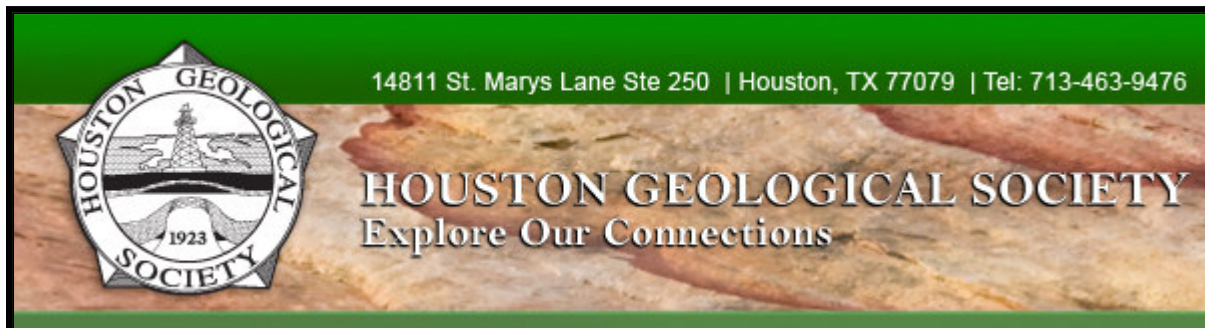

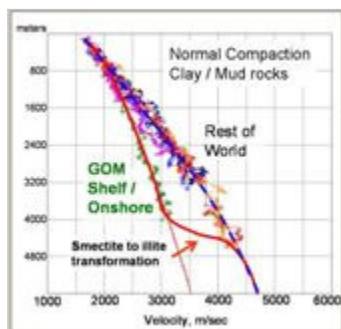


Hello David,

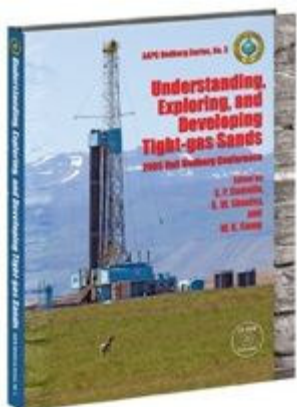
