

This gives oil and gas companies greater access to exploration and production opportunities in the U.S. than anywhere else in the world.

- Shale gas can significantly reduce the negative economic impact of imported oil but not in the near term due to slow market growth. - Shale gas may displace some coal and nuclear use but probably

energy needs of the nation.

- Shale oil will help to maintain and to increase US production modestly but its current EUR is probably not large enough to provide oil economic independence, let alone actual oil independence.
