I updated Under 50 Gallery 3 with cobaltoan calcite, pyrolusite, manganese nodules, barite, druzy quartz over chalcedony, stellerite, hessonite, quartz, cyanotrichite, sulphur and others on 8/15/12. The pyrolusite is from the 2009 find with extremely bright crystals of pyrolusite stacked on top of each other. It was a very limited find and nothing has been found since this pocket. The cobaltoan calcite is from the 2005 find. Due to miner's inability to remove specimens and lack of mineral finds, specimens have become even more scarce.
