Dick and Roy Jones found this lot of very good ramsdellite specimens in 1972 (This is the flats that were saved from that lot). Specimens from the type locality, Lake Valley, Sierra County, New Mexico, are considered the best of the species. Recent research has found that some of the crystals of ramsdellite have partially pseudomorphed into pyrolusite. Ramsdellite is a trimorph (minerals of the same chemical formula, but different shapes) with akhtenskite and pyrolusite. Ramsdellite is considered rare and seldom found with good crystals. The ramsdellite Gallery was created on 9/21/12.
