I created the Orange Scolecite, Mesolite, Cavansite with Calcite Gallery on 11/19/12. The orange scolecite is a rare color with an epimorphic association of chaledony that has had only one find.

The Mesolite on Thomsonite with Stilbite-Aurangabad, Maharashtra, India - has extremely aesthetic "balls" of thomsonite found in 2009 and mentioned in the Mineralogical Record (What's New In Minerals 10/08/09 with this specimen being pictured in the online article). The thomsonite balls have terminated crystals of mesolite that glitter in the sunlight. (I had first choice from the lot. These specimens have been "lost" in the warehouse since 2009).
