I updated Gallery 24 with kleinite, kinoite, toipaz with hyalite opal, phenakite, azurite, double refractory calcite, smithsonite, and others on 3/07/13.

The kleinite specimens, a rare mercury halide, are from an old stash from the 1990's that were hidden away in a garage. Kleinite is not current being found ( the McDermitt mine produces the best of the species.)

The kinoite specimens are a rare calcium copper silicate that were found in the 1960's. The Christmas Mine produces the best of the kinoite species.
