I updated Gallery 2 (3 pages) with pink/purple topaz, calcite on amethyst, hemnatite rose, azurite, arseniosiderite, imperial topaz, fuchsite in quartz, optical calcite, elbaite in quartz, calcite on cavansite, sphaerocobaltite, beryllonite with brazilianite and others on 4/24/13.

At the end of 2008, a deposit of purple topaz on quartz was found in Brumado, Bahia, Brazil. The majority was taken to Tucson by Luiz Menezes. He saved a limited number for Denver. Also, a very small lot was brought to me by one of the miners. (It seems as if the mine is seriously pursuing any miner that removes specimens with the penalty of being fired and imprisonment). Virtually none is now being found, but I have attempted to buy the best of the find. Although the topaz crystals are small, they have color that is both rare and appealing. (These are from a small lot I found in one of my flats).
