This new [Democratic Republic of Congo Update \(click here\)](#) features fine azurites from a new find at Kibwi, an excellent specimen of primary malachite crystals from the Tantara Mine and a deep pink cobaltoan calcite from Kolwesi.

Although the copper deposits of the Democratic Republic of Congo have been famous for

a long time, excellent crystallized azurite specimens are uncommon from the DRC (and have often been quite expensive). This lot is from a new find at Kibwi, located in Katanga, approximately 70 km northeast of Lubumbashi on the road to Likasi.
