Featured Mineral

Our November Mineral of the Month is pyrite, or iron disulfide, from Peru's Huanzala Mine. Our specimens consist of clusters of lustrous, striated pyritohedral crystals. The Huanzala Mine is a classic pyrite locality that has yielded more mineral specimens on a tonnage basis than any other mine in the world. As Peru's first great source of pyrite, Huanzala helped to develop that nation's booming mineral-specimen industry. Huanzala pyrite exhibits three of the four major habits of pyrite-cubic, octahedral, and dodecahedral (pentagonal-pyritohedral) and has a mirror-bright-to-satiny luster.
